


Eligible for CVD Intervention

The "Eligible for CVD Intervention" provides a snapshot of what was happening prior to the start of the CVD service on 1st April and shows patients which are eligible by meeting the following criteria:

- Are aged 35-60
- Have **not** received the full suite of CVD checks in the last 3 years:
 - a BP
 - a lipid profile or key element of this
 - a weight/BMI
 - an assessment of glycaemic level such as blood glucose/HbA1c
 - a smoking status asked

Any of the completed checks carried out prior to 1st April 2025, but less than 3 years will appear in Green while the others will be displayed in Grey.



Please note: This is a snapshot of their status at that time and should not change. There is no need to attempt to update this information – it will not be used for CVD achievement or payment verification.

Intervention Achievements

The Intervention Achievements section will show the current status of the CVD service's criteria for the patient. The patient will need to have completed at least 1 criteria after 1st April 2025 to appear in this section.



If the patient has a red X, there are unfulfilled criteria still to be completed.

If the patient has a green ✓, then you have completed all the criteria and you can claim for that patient.



If you expand the patient, you can see all the status of the specific checks/criteria.



The achievement measures are as follows:

- BP
- BMI, smoking status
- total cholesterol
- HDL cholesterol
- Diabetes assessment with score. A score of 16 or more indicates the requirement for either fasting blood glucose or HbA1c to be carried out.

The results of all those measures should then be used to carry out an ASSIGN score.

Appropriate advice should then be given - this is subject to scoring:

- ASSIGN score < 20 (or ASSIGN2 score <10) should offer lifestyle advice
- ASSIGN scores greater than this should be offered primary prevention advice.

Lastly, 'CVD assessment done' should be recorded to confirm this consultation has taken place.

All criteria must be completed post 1st April 2025 to be valid.

When all data points have been achieved, the patient will be valid for a claim.



Reports

You will currently have access to 3 reports for CVD. All 3 can be exported in various formats including PDF and excel spreadsheets.



You can export the report by selecting the Export button on the report preview. Additional options can be selected from the dropdown.



Eligible Patients will give you a list of all the eligible patients.

Commenced will show patients which have at least 1 criteria completed since the 1st April 2025, but not all have been completed yet.

CVD Achievement Commenced (data recorded since April 1st 2025)

NOTE:
If the diabetes assessment score is 16 or more, an HbA1c or FBG should be carried out.
The A SSIGN score and advice should be recorded after measures and blood results have been obtained.
If the A SSIGN score is 20 or more (10 or more for A SSIGN 2) then primary prevention advice should be given. Scores less than this should be given lifestyle advice. All patients should be given a CVD risk assessment as part of this consultation.






Running your Submission

The application will start loading your submission information. This may take a minute or more depending on the amount of data. You can check the progress via the progress bar at the bottom.






Once the submission data has been loaded, you will be presented with 3 tabs.


The **CVD** Tab will take you to the CVD - Enhanced Service Management Reporting section but for the month in question
